## **Gosport, Fareham and Solent Football League**

Formed 2013

The League

#### **Brief Summary**

Gosport, Fareham and Solent Football League, formed 2013, Affiliated to the Hampshire Football Association Limited and a member of the Portsmouth Divisional Football Association.

This season the Gosport, Fareham and Solent League has 26 Clubs / 31 Teams divided into three divisions, ten teams in Division One and Division Two and eleven teams in Division Three.

#### Location

Based in Gosport, Hampshire, England with Clubs accepted within a 10 mile radius.

#### **Brief History of the League**

The League was formed in 2013 from an amalgamation of the Gosport and Fareham League and the Solent Football League.

#### **Brief History of Gosport and Fareham League**

In 1904 The Gosport District League was formed and later became known as the Gosport and Fareham League.

#### **Brief History of Solent Football League**

The League called the Solent Premier League and was not affiliated to any associations, was formed in 1987 from Clubs of the Friendly League that started in 1971.

In 1995 the League applied for affiliation to the Hampshire Football Association who asked the Portsmouth Football Association to vet our application. It was suggested by the PFA that the League become the Solent Divisions of the Gosport and Fareham League.

In the 1995/6 season the Solent Premier League became the Solent Divisions of the G & F League. After two seasons the Solent Divisions decided to once again apply for affiliation, as the Solent Football League, to the HFA.

The application was successful and led, in the 1997/8 season, to the League's membership of the PFA now called the Portsmouth Divisional Football Association (PDFA).

#### **CLUB FORMED 2013**

### **Club History:**

LGS Rovers were formed back in 2013 after many years of discussing the idea of starting a 11-a-side team. Starting in the Meon Valley League, we initially struggled to get results but ended the season as the Hampshire FA Fair Play Award winners. Over the next few seasons with the additions of a few more experienced heads, the Lifters slowly went up the league table. This improvement was shown by the Lifters winning the Nicholson Cup with a 1-0 against-all-odds win against Denmead in 2017. The goalscorer that day was Dan Bayles towering above everyone to score a bullet header. The next season the Lifters were then awarded the Hampshire FA Charter Standard Club of the year.

In the 2019/20 season, LGS moved across to the Gosport, Fareham & Solent League starting off in Division 3. This was the first "Covid Season" so the season was cut short but not before the Lifters reached the Portsmouth Cup Final. Once the lockdown restrictions were lifted, the Lifters went on to Lift the Portsmouth Cup after beating Gosport Spartans 3-0 thanks to a Jon Hope Hat-trick.

What followed was a few years of struggles but after a few fresh additions this season, the Lifters are for more competitive this season and are looking forward to playing in their 3rd Cup Final in 11 years. After winning division 3, with a brace from Jon Hope in the title deciding game, LGS are looking to secure a club first league and cup double.



### Frank and Pat Marsden Challenge Cup



Frank Marsden's greatest love was football and he devoted all of his spare time to firstly running Arrow Athletic football teams and then in the 1950's he was appointed Treasurer of the Gosport and Fareham league, a post he held for 20 years. In 1973 he was elected Chairman of the Gosport and Fareham League and elected Life Vice President in 1975. In 1979 he was awarded Hants FA "services to football" trophy. Throughout this time Pat became a Life Vice President in her own right and gave Frank tremendous support. Frank was still a referee at the age of 70.

A challenge cup competition was started in 2016/2017 season in their memory.
